Heathrow woes called blow to britain's pride

LONDON — Britain's aviation minister called ongoing flight cancellations and baggage problems at Heathrow Airport's new Terminal 5 a blow to national pride.

Jim Fitzpatrick told lawmakers Monday it could be a week before a backlog of suitcases and bags is returned to their owners following glitches in the London terminal's high-tech baggage-handling system.

British Airways canceled 54 additional shorthaul flights at the terminal Monday.

Almost 300 flights have been scrapped and 28,000 bags have been separated from their owners since the terminal opened last week.
